Parking in School

Once again, I am concerned at the amount of cars being double parked. Small children cannot see over the top of cars and this type of parking makes it very dangerous. It may be inconvenient, it may take a couple of minutes but it is really important for the safety of all of our children that everyone is considerate and safe when parking in our car park. Also, I must ask again that cars are not parked on the yellow zig zags or in the bus bay: *no not even for 2 minutes!* The safety of our children is paramount.

Cycling to School

Children cycling and scooting to school really should be wearing safety helmets. We did have a near miss this week which has concerned me greatly. Children know not to use their cycle or scooter in the school grounds. They should dismount and push it for everyone's safety.

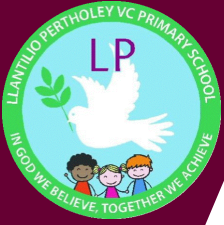

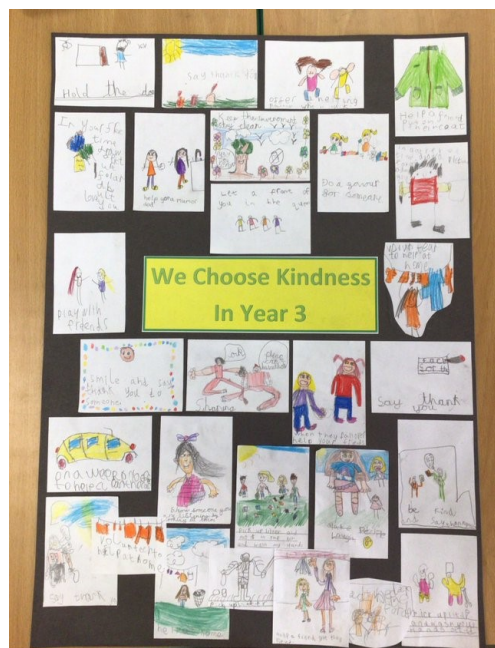
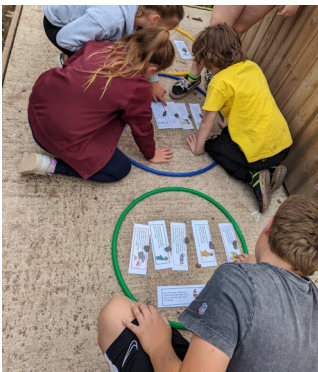
